This state of the art park was built by the Village of Orland Park in conjunction with Orland Township.



The Grinding Edge Skate Park is 25,000 square feet of concrete featuring a 5 foot pool, 6/8 ft. half pipe, elliptical block/bank, ramps, rails, a native rock and rail area, in addition to a very challenging street plaza that will provide endless hours of skating and skateboard adventure.

The skate park is open to individuals with skateboards and in-line skates only. Helmets are required for all skaters. Everyone younger than 13 years of age must also wear elbow, knee, and wrist pads.

## **ICE SKATING & SHELTER RULES**

For your child's safety, we recommend children age eight & under wear helmets.

- Children nine years of age and under must have adult supervision.
- No one is allowed on the ice while resurfacing is in progress.
- No one is allowed on the ice without ice skates.
- Figure skating spins and techniques will only be permitted when there are 30 or fewer skaters on the ice.
- Warming shelter visits limited to 30 minutes
- Only ice skating is permitted on the Winter Wonderland Ice Rink. Hockey is not allowed at any time.
- Skating direction to be determined by skate guards.
- Young skaters & beginners should remain in the center ice area.
- Please stay on rubber matting while wearing skates.
- Violation of these rules may result in dismissal from the park by the attendant on duty.

# **GENERAL PARK INFORMATION**

## **BOATING**

Boats with electric trolling motors will be allowed for fishing on Lake Sedgewick. Only watercraft that complies with state registration requirements and safety regulations will be allowed. All boaters, 16 years of age & younger must wear a life yest at all times.

## **DOGS IN PARKS**

All dogs shall be restrained at all times on adequate leashes no greater than five feet (5') in length. Any person responsible for the entry of a dog or other domestic animal shall immediately remove any animal droppings left by the animal to the nearest refuse container.

## PARK WATCH PROGRAM

Orland Park's park sites total over 650 acres of park land within the village. These facilities are maintained by the Parks Division of the Recreation & Parks Department for everyone to enjoy. Unfortunately, there have been occurrences of vandalism in parks within the village. Residents are asked to please be alert for any signs and sounds of vandalism in their neighborhood parks. To reduce vandalism in Orland Park's parks, the village is offering a \$200 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person(s) damaging village property. Should you see vandalism occurring, please immediately call the Orland Park Police at 708.349.4111.

## PICNICS, PICNIC KITS & SUPERCOOKERS

Permits are available to residents only for the Centennial Park Gazebo (not available Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day) Doogan Park, Hostert Log Cabin Area, Schussler Park, and Veterans Park at no charge (\$25 security deposit on a credit card is required). All renters are responsible for the general clean-up of their picnic area. Use of alcoholic beverages and/or narcotics is strictly prohibited on park grounds. A picnic kit is available (\$5 plus a \$25 deposit on a credit card), which includes a volleyball net and ball, 12" softball, 16" softball, softball bat, soccer ball and basketball. Picnic tables (\$8), barricades (\$3) and a Supercooker (\$50) may also be rented. One week notice is required for all rentals. For additional information on permits and availability, please contact the Recreation & Parks Department at 708.403.PARK.

### **PARK HOURS**

The village parks shall be open each day from daybreak until 9:00 PM, except parks with lights and parks wherein departmentally scheduled and supervised activities are occurring. Lighted parks shall close at 10:30 PM, and all ballfield lights shall be extinguished no later than 10:45 PM. (Ord. 1650, 3-2-87).
