Village of Orland Park Recreation & Parks Department Centennial Park Aquatic Center Rules

- Admission to the pool will be refused to all persons having contagious/infectious conditions such as; a cold, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesion, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, discharges or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions that have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages or other bandages of any kind will not be permitted.
- 2. Only lined swimsuits may be worn in the water. Cutoffs, unlined shorts (i.e. basketball shorts) and street clothes are not permitted in the pool. A clean, white T-shirt, or *water-shoes* may be worn.
- All children not toilet-trained are required to wear plastic pants over a swim diaper. Disposable diapers are strictly prohibited. Baby changing areas are provided in the locker rooms. Babies are not to be changed on the pool deck.
- 4. Patrons are encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool.
- 5. Patrons 5 & older should use the appropriate gender locker room or use the family changing room.
- 6. No cameras of any type are permitted in the locker rooms.
- 7. Loitering in or around the locker rooms is prohibited.
- 8. The CPAC will not open, or will close for the day, if: a) the air temperature is less than 68 degrees; b) hazardous weather conditions exist; or c) a situation arises that jeopardizes public health or safety.
- 9. Should the CPAC close early for any reason identified in item 3, a rain-check stamp will be issued. All patrons must present a receipt to receive a rain-check stamp. Rain-check stamps will be issued only to those present at the time of closing. Rain-check stamps expire at the end of the season. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**
- 10. A rain-check stamp will not be issued if: a) a patron has been at the CPAC for three or more hours; or b) a rain-check stamp from a previous date was used to enter the CPAC.
- 11. The CPAC reserves the right to close attractions, or the entire facility due to low attendance. In the event the CPAC closes early due to low attendance, **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**
- 12. CPAC staff will close all, or portions, of the pool periodically for safety breaks as deemed necessary by CPAC management staff.
- 13. Patrons leaving CPAC may reenter with a receipt and hand stamp. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
- 14. Persons violating pool rules or regulations, either written or verbal, will be subject to eviction, disciplinary action or arrest by the Police Department. There will be no refunds under these circumstances.
- 15. Persons appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior will not be admitted into the CPAC or will be removed from the premises and are subject to disciplinary action, including arrest, without refund.
- 16. All patrons are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner so as not to cause harm to themselves or others. Running, boisterous or rough play is not permitted.
- 17. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted.
- 18. Only plastic buckets or cups may be used by children 2 years and under, in any pool. No other toys or sports equipment are permitted in the CPAC.

- 19. An adult, 18 or older, must accompany children 11 years of age and under at all times. No child under the age of 12 is allowed to be in the CPAC without this supervision.
- 20. Patrons must be at least 40" tall and be able to swim unassisted to the exit stairs to ride any water slide.
- 21. Children less than 40" tall are required to wear a PFD and be accompanied by an adult in the Lazy River.
- 22. Only one person at a time may ride the slides. Parents/guardians may not ride with a child on their lap.
- 23. Diving is not permitted in any pool in the CPAC.
- 24. Only Class III Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) are permitted. PFDs are available, free of charge. Floaties are not permitted.
- 25. Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) are only permitted in the zero depth pool and the Lazy River.
- 26. Beginner swimmers and patrons unable to swim are required to use the shallow end of the pool and to avoid the deep end.
- 27. A parent or guardian must be within arms length of a child using a PFD.
- 28. Patrons may supervise a maximum of two participants utilizing PFDs.
- 29. All patrons must be in an inner-tube, feet off the bottom of the pool, when in the Lazy River.
- 30. Bags and coolers will be inspected by CPAC staff upon entrance to the CPAC for prohibited items.
- 31. Glass or other materials which may be hazardous or interfere with pool operations are not permitted.
- 32. Cigarettes, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, and gum are strictly prohibited. Smoking is prohibited throughout Centennial Park.
- 33. Coolers are permitted in the concession area only. Food, beverages, and coolers are not permitted on the pool deck or lawn.
- 34. The Village of Orland Park is not responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen property. **VALUABLES ARE NOT TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED.** Keys, phones, purses, wallets, cameras, and other items of value are not to be left unattended. Coin lockers are available in the men's & women's locker rooms for your convenience.
- 35. Strollers are permitted on the pool deck, but must remain behind the pool grates and must be attended to when in use.
- 36. Saving chairs is not permitted. It is permissible to bring a deck chair to the CPAC.
- 37. Lost and found articles may be claimed at the entrance desk. Unclaimed property will be donated after one (1) week
- 38. The public address system and phones are for official use only.
- 39. Bicycles must be secured in the designated secure bike rack areas.

CPAC management staff has the authority to implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or that supplement those listed. Persons violating regulations are subject to eviction or arrest, without refund.

The Village of Orland Park Recreation and Parks Department reserves the right to add, or reverse, rules as deemed necessary.
