Centennial Park Aquatic Center Rules 2014

- 1 Admission to the pool will be refused to all persons having contagious/infectious conditions such as; a cold, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesion, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, discharges or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious.

Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions that have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages or other bandages of any kind will not be permitted in the water.

- 2 Only lined swim trunks or board shorts may be worn in the water. *White* board shorts, cutoffs, unlined shorts (i.e. basketball shorts) and street clothes are not permitted in the pool. A clean white T-shirt or *water-shoes* may be worn.

Women may wear shorts, as outlined above, over a female swimsuit. A burqini is permitted in the water.

Those not in proper swim attire, may only enter the water up to their knees in the zero depth pool.

- 3 All children not toilet-trained are required to wear plastic pants over a *swim* diaper. Disposable diapers are strictly prohibited. Baby changing areas are provided in the locker rooms. Babies are not to be changed on the pool deck. Swim pants and swim diapers are available for purchase at the cashier's desk.
- 4 Patrons 5 & older should use the appropriate gender locker room or use the family changing room.
- 5 Cameras, of any type, are prohibited in the locker rooms.
- 6 Loitering in or around the locker rooms is prohibited.
- 7 CPAC will not open, or will close for the day, if: a) the air temperature is less than 69 degrees, b) hazardous weather conditions exist, or c) a situation arises that jeopardizes public health or safety.
- 8 Should CPAC close early for any reason identified in item #7, a rain-check stamp will be issued. All patrons must present a receipt to receive a rain-check stamp. Rain check stamps will be issued only to those present at the time of closing. Rain-check stamps expire at the end of the season. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**
- 9 A rain-check stamp will not be issued if: a) a patron has been at CPAC for three or more hours; or b) a rain-check stamp from a previous date was used to enter CPAC.
- 10 CPAC reserves the right to close attractions, or the entire facility due to low attendance. In the event that CPAC closes early due to low attendance, **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.** Rain checks will be issued except as outline in #9.
- 11 CPAC staff will close all, or portions, of the pool periodically for safety breaks as deemed necessary by CPAC management staff.
- 12 Patrons leaving CPAC may reenter with a receipt and hand stamp. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**
- 13 Persons violating pool rules or regulations, either written or verbal, will be subject to eviction, disciplinary action or arrest by the Police Department. There will be no refunds under these circumstances.
- 14 Persons appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior will not be admitted into CPAC or will be removed from the premise and are subject to disciplinary action, including arrest, without refund.
- 15 All patrons are expected to conduct themselves in such a manner so as not to cause harm to themselves or others. Running, boisterous or rough play is not permitted.
- 16 Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted.
- 17 Only plastic buckets or cups may be used by children 2 years and under in any pool. Other toys and/or sports equipment are permitted at the discretion of CPAC management staff based upon the conditions of the day (number of people in the pool).

18. An adult, 18 or older, must accompany children 11 years of age and under at all times. No child under the age of 12 is allowed to be in CPAC without this supervision.
19. Patrons must be at least 40" tall and able to swim unassisted to the water attraction's exit stairs, to use any water attraction.
20. Children less than 40" tall are required to wear a PFD *and* be accompanied by an adult in the Lazy River.
21. Only one person at a time may ride the slides. Parents/guardians may not ride with a child on their lap.
22. Diving is not permitted in any of CPAC's pools.
23. Only Coast Guard Approved Personal Floatation Devices (PFDs) are permitted. PFDs are available, free of charge. Other PFD's are permitted only at the discretion of CPAC management staff. Arm floats are not permitted.
24. Patrons whom are unable to swim proficiently and keep their airway above the water without assistance are required to stay in the shallow end of the zero depth pool.
25. A parent or guardian must be within a reasonable distance of a child using a PFD as deemed appropriate by CPAC staff.
26. All patrons must be on, or within, an inner-tube, when in the Lazy River. Running/pushing of other patrons and boisterous play in the Lazy River is not permitted.
27. Bags and coolers will be inspected by CPAC staff upon entrance to CPAC for prohibited items.
28. Glass or other materials which may be hazardous, or interfere with pool operations are not permitted.
29. Cigarettes, including e-cigarettes, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, and gum are strictly prohibited. Smoking is prohibited throughout Centennial Park except at designated locations.
30. Coolers are permitted in the concession & pavilion areas only. Food, beverages and coolers are not permitted on the pool deck or lawn unless needed to store required medications (i.e. insulin).
31. The Village of Orland Park is not responsible for damaged, lost or stolen property. **VALUABLES ARE NOT TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED.** Keys, phones, purses, cameras, etc are of value and are not to be left unattended. Coin lockers are available in the men's & women's locker rooms for your convenience.
32. Strollers are permitted on the pool deck, but must remain behind the pool overflow grates and must be attended to when in use.
33. Saving chairs is not permitted. It is permissible to bring a deck chair to CPAC. Umbrellas are permitted on the lawn, however are subject to approval by CPAC management staff.
34. Lost and found articles may be claimed at the entrance desk. Unclaimed property will be donated after one (1) week.
35. The public address system and phones are for official use only. Paging of patrons is not permitted.
36. Bicycles must be secured in the designated secure bike rack areas at the entrance area of the pool.
37. Breath holding games and activities that place patrons at risk of blackout and drowning are strictly prohibited.
38. T-Pool lap lanes are reserved for lap swimming only.
39. A snorkel blocks the airway of a swimmer. A snorkel mask prevents guards from seeing the facial expression of a drowning victim. The use of either a snorkel or a snorkel mask is strictly prohibited.

CPAC management staff has the authority to implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or that supplement those listed. Persons violating regulations are subject to eviction or arrest, without refund.

The Village of Orland Park Recreation and Parks Department reserves the right to add, or reverse, rules as deemed necessary.
